She was **CANONIZED** by Pope John Paul II who was greatly **INSPIRED** by the Divine Mercy message.

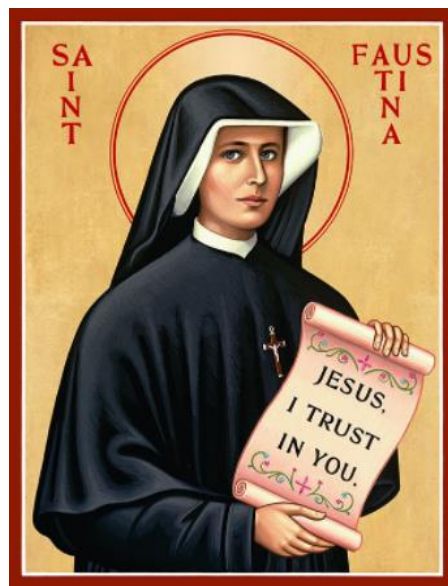
