QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

- Did Jacob, the paralytic, believe Jesus could help him? Why not?
- What was your reaction when Jacob confessed that he didn't have faith?
- Have you ever doubted Jesus would/could help you? Were you right?
- 4. Is there a connection between faith and healing? If so, what is it?
- 5. Why is the reaction of Jacob's friends to his doubt important? Share a similar experience as either Jacob or one of the disciples.
- 6. Why did Jesus start by forgiving Jacob's sin?
- 7. What if Jacob's paralysis hadn't been healed? Would the effort still have been worth it?
- 8. How does this story apply to your life?
