## Family Page: Ch. 4 – The Holy Spirit Guides Us

Review:

Vocabulary

- Holy Spirit – The Holy Spirit is God, Who comes to us and guides the Church
- Trinity – The Trinity means that there are three Persons – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit – in one God

Discussion Question:

How does the Holy Spirit guide us?

Activity:

Go outside on a windy day and “watch the wind.” The wind is a symbol of the Holy Spirit because we can not see the wind itself, but we can see its effects on other things. Pay attention to how the wind affects things. Enjoy the breeze and talk about how the Holy Spirit can move and guide us, just like the wind guides the things it blows.
