Grade 3, Chapter 5 – God Becomes Man

Bible story connections:

- Genesis 3:1-15
- Luke 1:26-38
- Matthew 1:18-23

Social Justice tie-in:

• Preferential Option for the Poor – When God became a man, He was born to a poor family. If there is a Loaves and Fishes or other food bank, collect food and set up a volunteer field trip to help on a Saturday morning.

Discussion Questions:

- Why did Adam and Eve disobey God?
- God could have come to the world any way He wanted. Why did He come as a poor Baby instead of as a powerful warrior?

Memory Work (Baltimore Catechism):

80. Why is Jesus Christ God?

Jesus Christ is God because He is the only Son of God, having the same divine nature as His Father.

81. Why is Jesus Christ man?

Jesus Christ is man because He is the Son of the Blessed Virgin Mary and has a body and soul like ours.

87. When was the Son of God conceived and made man?

The Son of God was conceived and made man on Annunciation Day, the day on which the Angel Gabriel announced to the Blessed Virgin Mary that she was to be the Mother of God.
