### Review:

#### Vocabulary

- Good Friday – The day on which Jesus died for us
- Easter – The celebration of Jesus rising from the dead three days after He was crucified
- Resurrection – When Jesus rose from the dead on the first Easter Sunday

1) What did Jesus do on the first Easter Sunday?

*God*

2) Will you someday rise from the dead?

*Yes, because of Jesus, we will rise from the dead*
