

Grade 2, Chapter 10 – Mary is our Mother

Bible story connections:

- Genesis 3:14-15
- Luke 1:26-38
- Revelation 12:1-6, 17

Social Justice tie-in:

- Beatitude: Blessed are the pure of heart – Mary was completely pure of heart, and she always did what God asked of her. Make a Marian bulletin board or set up a statue of Mary in the school or parish and encourage others to look to Mary as a model.

Discussion Questions:

- Why is Mary the perfect model for us as followers of Jesus?
- Why is it important to talk to Mary and have a relationship with her?

Memory Work (Baltimore Catechism):

62. Was any person ever preserved from Original Sin?

The Blessed Virgin Mary was preserved from Original Sin in view of the merits of her divine Son; and this privilege is called her Immaculate Conception.

178. Has the body of any human person ever been raised from the dead and taken into Heaven?

By the special privilege of her Assumption, the body of the Blessed Virgin Mary, united to her immaculate soul, was glorified and taken into Heaven.
