

## Grade 4, Chapter 7 – The Life of Christ

Bible story connections:

- John 6:1-15
- Luke 8:40-56
- Luke 10:1-12

Social Justice tie-in:

- Corporal Work of Mercy – Give Drink to the Thirsty – Jesus provided for the thirsty. Learn about a charity that provides clean drinking water in third world countries, promote it, and collect money for it.

Discussion Questions:

- Why are Jesus's miracles important?
- Why do you think Jesus spoke to the people in parables?

Memory Work (Baltimore Catechism):

89C. What work did Jesus Christ perform in the course of His public ministry?
