- Eucharist – The Body and Blood of Jesus, given to us as food. At Mass, bread and wine become Jesus' Body and Blood.
- Last Supper – A special meal that Jesus had with His Apostles before He died. Jesus gave us the Eucharist at the Last Supper.
- Apostles – The twelve men that Jesus chose to be the first leaders of His Church
- Holy Communion – When we receive Jesus in the Eucharist at Mass
