Review:

Vocabulary

- Penitential – Focusing on penance or sorrow for our sins
- Lent – Forty days before Easter, during which we use prayer and fasting to prepare to celebrate Jesus rising from the dead
- Triduum – The holy days at the end of Lent, just before Easter – from Holy Thursday to Easter Sunday
- Easter – The celebration of Jesus rising from the dead three days after He was crucified
