Bible story connections:

Social Justice tie-in:

• Solidarity – Throw a Baptism party for another class in the school, celebrating their identities as children of God. If you have "prayer partners" do it for them, or maybe a preschool class. Bring treats and help them understand why Baptism is something special to celebrate!

Memory Work (Baltimore Catechism):

315. What is Baptism?

Baptism is the sacrament that gives our souls the new life of sanctifying grace by which we become children of God and heirs of Heaven.

316. What sins does Baptism take away?

Baptism takes away Original Sin; and also actual sin and all the punishment due to them, if the person baptized be guilty of any actual sins and truly sorry for them.

318. Who can administer Baptism?

The priest or a deacon is the usual minister of Baptism, but if there is danger that someone will die without Baptism, anyone else may and should baptize.
