January 1 — Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God

Gospel - Adapted from Luke 2:16-21

The shepherds hurried to Bethlehem and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger. When they saw this, they told them the message they had been told about this child. Everyone who heard it was amazed by what the shepherds said. And Mary reflected on all these things in her heart. Then the shepherds returned, giving glory to God, and praising him for everything they had seen

and heard, just as they had beentold by the angels.

After eight days, the baby was circumcised and given the name Jesus, the name given to him by the angel before he was conceived.

Reflection

Today we celebrate the feast of Mary, Mother of God, and the Gospel brings us back to Christmas night. Mary and Joseph are in the stable with the newborn Baby Jesus, when some visitors arrive. They are shepherds, who have received a message about the miraculous birth from a group of angels. Isn't this amazing? These shepherds – poor, dirty, uneducated – are the first people God calls to His Son. These shepherds had faith. God gives them a message, He calls them, and they follow.

When they got to the stable, they found Mary and Joseph with the Baby. Mary must have been surprised, but she welcomed them to adore her Son. And the Gospel tells us something else: "Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart." Mary heard the amazing thing that God

did for the shepherds, and she reflected on it in her heart. Mary always takes the things that God does to heart, and she reflects on them. She doesn't ignore them, or forget about them; she keeps them in her heart and learns from them. She allows the things that God does to shape who she is. That is why she follows God and loves Him so perfectly. She is a model for us. God is always acting in our lives; He is always speaking to us through the Scripture; He is on our altars at Mass. Do we pay attention? Do we stop to reflect on what God does, and allow it to change us? If not, let us start today.
