# Gospel - Adapted from Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18

Jesus said to his disciples, "Do not do good deeds just so other people may see them; otherwise, you will have no reward from your heavenly Father. When you give to the poor, do not blow a trumpet, like the hypocrites do so they can be praised by others. Truly, they have already received their reward. But when you give to the poor, do so privately so your generosity may be secret, and your Father, who sees what is secret, will reward you.

"When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, who love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on street corners, so everyone can see that they are praying. Truly, they have already received their reward. But when you pray, go to your room, shut the door, and pray to your Father in secret. And your Father, who sees what is secret, will reward you.

"When you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites They make themselves look weak, so everyone can see they are fasting. Truly, they have already received their reward. But when you fast, brush your hair and wash your face, so others can not tell that you are fasting, except your Father who is hidden. And your Father, who sees what is hidden, will reward you."


## Reflection

Today is Ash Wednesday, the first day of the season of Lent. Lent is a penitential season. It is a season of prayer, fasting, and good works. But these are things we can and should be doing throughout the year.

The season of Lent challenges us to ask: "Why do I pray? Why do I fast? Why do I do good works?" Do I pray only because my parents make me, or is there something more? - **Hypocrite** Someone who is fake, or who says one thing, but does another. Jesus tells us that our spiritual works must be done for spiritual reasons. If we do them to gain praise or earthly rewards, we are being hypocrites.
- **Lent -** The forty-day season before Easter. It is a season of prayer, fasting, and good works, in which we commit to turning away from sin, and growing closer to God.
